- Payments must be received by the **WEDNESDAY** prior to the week of attendance to ensure your spot. Space in Day Camp is limited and registration is accepted on a first come, first served basis.
- <u>Preference is given to families who need the service on a consistent basis.</u> If you fail to bring your child consistently, your spot may be given to someone on the waitlist.
- Space in the upcoming week will not be guaranteed without payment. Please see the registration form for exact dates.
- Payments can be made by exact cash amount, check or credit/debit card. Checks resulting in insufficient funds will be charged a return fee and eliminated as a method of payment.
- Refunds may be granted if the request is made the **WEDNESDAY** prior to that week of Day Camp. There are no partial refunds for weeks not fully attended. This includes removal from the program due to disciplinary reasons and/or sickness.
- In the event of outstanding, incomplete or non-payment, your family will be unable to attend Club activities until payment has been made in full, no exceptions.
- If paying with cash, please come with the exact total as our Clubs do not carry change.
- Payments are accepted from 9:00 a.m. 5:30 p.m. Only authorized personnel (Membership Clerk or Branch Manager) can accept payments.

## **Special Needs**

The Club is committed to providing the best possible experience for all participants. If your child has any special needs, please communicate those needs with staff at the time of registration. Our ratios are 1 adult for 20 youth in Day Camp and 1 adult for 15 youth for fieldtrips. We cannot provide one-on-one support. Children must be able to participate within their groups.

If your child requires medication while they are at the Club, please make sure to complete the medication form. Staff cannot administer medication without a completed form on file.

#### SWAG Program

Summer With A Goal (SWAG) is an educational program offered to all members who attend the Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater San Diego Summer Day Camp. SWAG was designed to include engaging and fun academic activities into the typical Summer Day Camp experience. You can expect to see SWAG happening throughout the summer.

A variety of activities will be offered during the SWAG hour. For a more detailed schedule of SWAG activities, please see your Branch Manager.

## **Adventure Camp Expectations**

Camp hours are **7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m**. Most Adventure Camp trips leave at 9:00 am (some may be earlier, please check schedule to ensure you are on time.) Members need to be checked in and ready to go as the bus will be loaded and leaving on time each day. If a member misses the bus they will be able to remain at the club but will be assigned to help a younger group for the day. Members who repeatedly miss the bus will be subject to removal from the program. Below you will find important policies and day-to-day procedures that will most likely apply to you. For a full listing of Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater San Diego policies and guidelines, please consult the Parent Handbook. You can obtain a copy from the Club or online at www.sdyouth.org. *Please read through and initial the following:* 

- Please instruct your child that he/she should not leave the building unless accompanied by an adult staff member. This rule will also be stressed and reinforced by Boys & Girls Club staff.
- Please be prepared to show your I.D. at all times. Anyone picking up a Club Member must provide identification to the front desk at the time of pick up. No person will be allowed to remove children from the Club if they are not listed as an authorized person on the membership application, even if the child recognizes them.
- Club hours are 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Please make the necessary arrangements to have your child/children picked-up no later than 5:30 p.m. Any pick-up after 5:30 p.m. is considered a late pick-up. After 3 late pick-ups, your child/children will be dropped from the program.
- Members MUST bring their own Lunch and snacks each day throughout the summer. We do not have bowls, plates or the ability to cook lunches.
- The Club is not responsible for lost or stolen items. All belongings, especially swimsuits and towels, should be taken home every day. Lost and Found is held for a period of one week and then donated to a charitable organization. This includes cell phones or any electronic device. – Please leave all valuables at home!
- Children are allowed to have cell phones with them but are expected to remain engaged in the programming offered. They may respond to a parent's call or text, but otherwise are not to be on phones or any type of electronics while at the Boys & Girls Club. The Club is not responsible for lost or stolen phones or other valuables. The Club is not responsible for the content viewed by your child or other children on member's personal cell phones.
- Field Trips or "Stay at the Club Events" occur each week. All Club Members are expected to follow all rules for the safety of themselves and others. Failure to follow the rules at off-site trips will result in removal from future trips.
- We consider our programs to be a partnership between the families and Club staff. We will do what is necessary to make this a successful summer for you and your child/children. We ask that all parents, guardians and family members please show respect to our staff, volunteers and other members. Any aggressive or disrespectful behavior will not be tolerated and will be subject to removal from the programs.
- To ensure the safety of all participants, the Club will not serve children whose behavior is likely to result in injury to themselves or others, who are at risk to leave the premises without permission, whose disability is so severe they cannot participate in a majority of Club activities, who require assistance to use the toilet or who require a personal aide while attending school and whose aide does not accompany them at all times to the Club.

Adventure Campers utilize the Buddy System, which means all members will be paired up for field trips and will be required to stay within visual contact of the staff at all times. In case someone becomes separated from the larger group, members will be able to call the Club office to contact Club staff and become reunited with their group. If you do not want to allow your child to participate in the buddy system, and would rather your child physically stay with the staff, please check here:

#### FIELD TRIP POLICY (Please initial below):

- All trip participants are required to follow trip guidelines at all times. The guidelines are as follows:
  - must adhere to all staff directions and instructions
  - must remain with assigned group and staff member
  - o must follow all safety rules and regulations on the bus and during the trip
  - o must refrain from vulgar and obscene language and gestures
  - All trip participants are required to follow water safety rules at all times. The guidelines are as follows:
    - Please come prepared to swim in appropriate swim wear
    - Flip flops or other sandals should be worn on the pool deck only.
    - Children who are unable to swim competently will be given a life vest to wear for the duration of the swim time. Please let the Branch Manager know ahead of time regarding your child's swimming ability.
    - Staff are not allowed to apply sunscreen.
- Disobedient and rowdy behavior will not be tolerated. If a participant does not follow these rules, he/she will be prohibited from attending future trips.
- Members may not be picked up or dropped off at a field trip location. They can only be signed out at the Club site, according to Club policy.
- It is mandatory to wear a Club t-shirt on all trips. Two shirts will be provided and additional shirts may be purchased.
- Participants must arrive at the Club <u>on time</u> so that they may be assigned a group and properly checked in. There will be <u>no refunds</u> or exchanges given on trips missed due to a late arrival.
